

THE WOMEN OF EASTER

If you're looking for a book to read in the weeks leading up to the celebration of Easter this year, here's the one to choose. It will help you discover new ways to prepare for the most important holiday on the Christian calendar.



As a Bible teacher and novelist, Higgs presents a study of the three Marys who walked closely with the Lord. She unfolds, in clear language, how each one spent the final days of Jesus' life in preparation for his death on Calvary's cross and the three days leading to his resurrection.

Higgs explores the purpose each one – Mary of Bethany, Mary of Nazareth and Mary Magdalene played. Each had very different roles, but each Mary was essential. While reading and studying the scriptures of the final days of the life of Jesus, you will be forced to look into your own heart and purpose to prepare for and celebrate Easter of 2022 anew.
